


*A Service

When all are gathered the Padre shall say:

“We have come today to remember before Almighty God, with grateful thanks, those who have died in the defence of justice and freedom in the service of our country, and its cause, especially those from this our town of Weston-super-Mare. Those whose memory we treasure, and all who have lived and died in the service of mankind”.

PADRE: “They shall grow not old as we that are left grow old
Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn,
At the going down of the sun and in the morning
We will remember them”.

EVERYONE shall repeat: “We will remember them”.

(Parade Marshall “Present Arms”)
Then shall ‘LAST POST’ be sounded
Following which a two minutes ‘SILENCE’ will be kept.

Then shall ‘REVEILLE’ be sounded.

‘KOHIMA EPITAPH’

PADRE shall say:

“When you go home, tell them of us and say,
For your tomorrow, we gave our today”.
(Parade Marshall “Shoulder Arms”)

THE LAYING OF THE WREATHS

Following the laying of the Town Mayor’s, Civic and other Wreaths the first Hymn will be sung.

HYMN:

We pray that we may be worthy of the sacrifice made on our behalf.

“Teach us good Lord, to serve thee as thou deservest;

to fight and not to heed the wounds;
to toil and not to seek for rest;
to labour and not to ask for any reward, save that of knowing that we do thy will;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

“We beseech you, O God, that all in authority, both in central and local government, and in other countries beyond the sea might seek and therefore receive the wisdom that comes from you alone, and that in the pursuit of law and order, nationally and internationally, they might know, and respond to your perfect will, that true peace will be restored worldwide”.

“And so we pray, with millions of other people around the world, for Statesmen and Rulers, that they may have wisdom to know and courage to do what is right”.

“For men and women all over the world of different race, colour or creed, that all may have justice, freedom, security and peace”.

“Lord, in Your Mercy”
Response: “Hear our Prayer”.

We commit you
The Lord bless you and keep you
The Lord make his face to shine upon you
And be gracious unto you
The Lord lift up the light of his countenance upon you
And give you his peace this day and always. **Amen”**
